Everyone is talking about the fascinating sport of Synchronized Skating and in response to the great demand, the Wissahickon Skating Club is proud to again offer instruction for non-club members this winter.

Our Introduction to Synchronized Skating Clinic has attracted Public Group Lessons skaters for the past few years because it is a way to learn about this exciting sport *without* making a full club membership commitment. Past students have benefited from being able to apply what they've learned so far in the Basic Skills series to a team sport that builds on their current skills.

The sport of Synchronized Skating is presently being considered for addition in the Winter Olympic Games and is also under consideration to be recognized as an NCAA sport! Combining several skaters on a team and skating "In Sync" is what the sport is all about. A team consists of between 8–20 skaters who skate to music in various formations such as circles, lines, blocks, wheels, and intersections at the same time.
