



## FAQ Regarding Program Offerings During Reconstruction

**Q: Where will the 2019-20 Youth Hockey Evaluations be conducted?**

A: Evaluations will be at Hatfield Ice (Green Rink) in April. Online Registration information coming soon!

**Q: Will there be a Youth Hockey Spring League?**

A: Yes. We will offer a Spring League at the Mite, Squirt, and Pee wee/Bantam Levels. Information will be emailed out to all Youth Hockey members by March 12<sup>th</sup>. The league(s) would start 4/6 and 4/7.

**Q: Will there be Spring Hockey Clinics?**

A: No. In place of the Spring Clinics, we will have team practices in May and June at Hatfield Ice (Green Rink) and/ or Old York Road. Dates and times for the practices will be communicated after Evaluations.

**Q: Where should Spring Figure Skating Ice Be Purchased?**

A: The club has communicated our reconstruction timeline to area rinks and figure skating clubs to ensure Wiss skaters are warmly welcomed.

**Q: Will the Dave Bauer Hockey Camp be offered this summer?**

A: Yes. We will run the Dave Bauer Camp (June 24 – 28) at Hatfield Ice (Green Rink).

**Q: Will the Colgate Camp be offered this summer?**

A: No.

**Q: Will the Youth Hockey Teams practice in August?**

A: Yes. The August team practices will take place. Practice dates, times and location are TBA at this time and will be communicated in June as we track the reconstruction timeline.

**Q: Will there be an Adult Learn-To-Play Clinic this off-season?**

A: No.

## FAQ Regarding Reconstruction Logistics

**Q: When will reconstruction begin?**

A: We will begin on the morning of March 25. Prior to that date you will notice some pre-construction work (removal of banners, etc.) being done.

**Q: How long do you expect reconstruction to take?**

A: We expect to have all construction complete and the rink reopened by September 1, 2019.

**Q: Will there be a special schedule during the final Club weekend of March 23 and 24?**

A: Yes. We will be announcing the schedule shortly.

**Q: Will there be an event to commemorate the achievement of this milestone?**

A: Yes. In the late afternoon-early evening of Sunday, March 24 we will have a BYOB open house and family skate to take one last look before work begins.

**Q: Will there be opportunities for Wiss members to do volunteer work during reconstruction?**

A: Likely, yes. We will know more after further consultation with the contractors.
