Welcome to the 63rd season of the Wissahickon Skating Club, and to the rebirth of our beautiful facility. As you read this, our employees, volunteers, and contractors are scrambling to complete countless final tasks before our Grand-Reopening Day celebration at noon on **Saturday**, **September 7** (schedule below). In past correspondence I have referred to the Old Barn and wavy boards. No more. Our new ice skating rink is nothing short of spectacular. It is longer by five feet, re-positioned, includes real benches and boxes, and...yes: straight boards! Countless other changes await. Beyond the rink, we have reconfigured bleachers with beautiful glass safety walls and overhead heat, locker rooms are refreshed or completely remodeled. We have a new sound system and a new scoreboard. A fresh coat of asphalt on the driveway and paint throughout are welcome changes. And don't miss the donor-brick wall.

In short, you will be awed by the work completed in only a few short months. For this we owe ourselves-as contributors and volunteers-a big pat on the back. Equally important, our employees, as members of the Wiss Family, deserve our deep gratitude for their creativity, craftsmanship, and remarkably long hours remodeling member spaces. I look forward to seeing you at Wiss, both now and well into the future.


