



Wissahickon Skating Club COVID-19 Cleaning Protocol

Purpose of Cleaning and Disinfecting:

This guidance provides recommendations on the cleaning and disinfection of rooms or areas occupied by those with suspected or with confirmed COVID-19. It is aimed at limiting the survival of SARS-CoV-2 in key environments. These recommendations will be updated if additional information becomes available.

These guidelines are focused on community, non-healthcare facilities such as schools, institutions of higher education, offices, daycare centers, businesses, and community centers that do, and do not, house persons overnight. These guidelines are not meant for [cleaning staff in healthcare facilities](#) or repatriation sites, [households](#), or for others for whom specific guidance already exists.

Definitions of Cleaning and Disinfecting:

Cleaning refers to the removal of dirt and impurities, including germs, from surfaces. Cleaning alone does not kill germs. But by removing the germs, it decreases their number and therefore any risk of spreading infection.

Disinfecting works by using chemicals, for example EPA-registered disinfectants, to kill germs on surfaces. This process does not necessarily clean dirty surfaces or remove germs. But killing germs remaining on a surface after cleaning further reduces any risk of spreading infection.

Protocols and Cleaning Procedures:

Areas within the facility that are touched frequently by people will be cleaned three times a day, at 7 am, 12 pm and 7 pm, using CDC-10 non-acidic clinging disinfectant cleaner.

- door handles
- push plates

- faucets
- toilet flush valves
- toilet seats
- vending machine buttons

Staff will disinfect all frequently touched objects in the unoccupied zone between each skate and the end of the night providing the next group with sanitized surfaces. The staff will utilize battery operated backpack sprayers and hand held [electrostatic sprayers](#) to deliver disinfecting COVID-19 rated disinfecting agents such as [BruTabs](#).

- Chairs
- Player benches
- Dasher board doors
- Faucets
- door handles
- push plates
